ORDINANCE NO. 1021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BRIDGEVILLE, AMENDING ITS CODE OF ORDINANCES, CH. 13, LICENSES, PERMITS & GENERAL BUSINESS REGULATIONS, PART 2, TRANSIENT RETAIL MERCHANTS, §205.E, PROHIBITED ACTS, AND PART 3, SOLICITATION OF CONTRIBUTIONS, §303.G, CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH PERMIT IS ISSUED, TO ESTABLISH UPDATED RULES REGARDING PERMISSIBLE AND PROHIBITED DAYS AND HOURS DURING WHICH ONE MAY OR MAY NOT ENGAGE IN LAWFUL DOOR-TO-DOOR SOLICITATIONS OR OTHER COVERED ACTIVITIES, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, in order to further protect the health, safety and welfare of the community, Borough Council is authorized under the Borough Code and otherwise under law to regulate door-to-door sales and other transient retail merchant activities, and certain charitable solicitation activities, through permit and licensing requirements and other rules and regulations, including rules establishing permissible and prohibited days and hours of operation;

WHEREAS, as recommended by the Public Safety Committee, Borough Council wishes to amend Chapter 13, Part 2, §205.E, and Chapter 13, Part 3, §303.G, to establish updated rules regarding permissible and prohibited days and hours during which licensed door-to-door and other transient merchants, and persons engaged in soliciting charitable contributions, may or may not engage in lawful door-to-door solicitations or other covered business or solicitation activities within the Borough;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bridgeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

I. That the Bridgeville Borough Code Of Ordinances, Chapter 13, Licenses, Permits and General Business Regulations, Part 2, Transient Retail Merchants, §205.E, Prohibited Acts, is hereby amended to provide, in full, as follows:

§205. Prohibited Acts

- E. Engage in any business activity, except by prior appointment, at any time on Sunday, or on any legal holiday, or at any time before 10:00 a.m. or after dusk on any day of the week other than a Sunday or a legal holiday.*

II. That the Bridgeville Borough Code Of Ordinances, Chapter 13, Licenses, Permits and General Business Regulations, Part 3, Solicitation of Contributions, §303.G, Conditions under which Permit is Issued, is hereby amended to provide, in full, as follows:

§303. Conditions under which Permit is Issued.

G. ***That the Applicant agrees that he/she shall not be permitted to*** engage in any business activity, except by prior appointment, at any time on Sunday, or ***on any*** legal holiday, or at any time before ***10:00 a.m. or after dusk*** on any day of the week other than a Sunday or ***a*** legal holiday.*

III. That all ordinances or portions of any ordinances which conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

IV. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

V. That the provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment or as otherwise provided under law.
