AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGETON, MISSOURI AMENDING CHAPTER 515.092 OF THE CITY’S CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING ELECTRONIC MESSAGE CENTERS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bridgeton, Missouri finds that it is in the best interest of the City to amend Chapter 515.092 of the City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGETON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. Section 515.092 A(2) of the Bridgeton Code of Ordinances is hereby amended and restated to read as follows:

In residential zoned districts, reader boards shall be permitted, provided such reader boards are fifteen (15) feet in area or less and are located at hospitals, churches, synagogues or other similar places of worship, community centers, public or private schools or buildings or structures owned or leased and used by other public, semi-public, or civic organizations. In residential zoned districts, electronic message centers shall only be permitted in public parks owned or operated by the City. Except as provided in the immediately preceding sentence, electronic message centers are not permitted in residential zoned districts and may not be permitted in residential districts as part of a sign package under Section 515.120 of the Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.


