AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGETON, MISSOURI REPEALING ORDINANCE NO 23-54 AND ADOPTING A NEW ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND OTHER COMPENSATION OF THE CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY, AS PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 8.04 OF THE CHARTER AND SECTION 115 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BRIDGETON, MISSOURI FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGETON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 REPEALER Ordinance No 23-54, relating to salaries and wages for classified employees, is hereby repealed.

Section 2 ESTABLISHMENT there is hereby established a basic compensation plan for all classified employees of the City of Bridgeton

Section 3 PAY PLAN CLASSIFICATION The illustrated compensation schedule in sections that follow in this ordinance shall constitute the basic compensation plan

1. A pay rate number designates the salary and wage range for each job title. This shall be known as a pay level. Each pay level shall consist of an entry or starting rate and the end or top of the range. Advancement within the pay level for any given employee is dependent upon merit. Merit increases shall be considered in July of each year.

Section 4 POSITION CLASSIFICATIONS – FULL TIME EMPLOYEES The following positions of employment or job titles shall fall within the classified group of employees of the City and shall be assigned compensation rates as indicated.

Section 5 **EMPLOYEES NOT ENTITLED TO FRINGE BENEFITS** None of the employees or positions listed or referred to in Section 5 are entitled to any of the employee benefits normally referred to as "fringe" benefits given to full time/regular employees: to wit, vacation, sick leave, or participation in group health plans, retirement/pension plan, etc.


