AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING ITS DISPOSAL

WHEREAS, the Village of Brownstown, Illinois, an Illinois Municipal Corporation, owns personal property as indicated on Exhibit 1 attached hereto and currently located as indicated on the exhibit; and

WHEREAS, the personal property on Exhibit 1 is no longer necessary or useful to, or in the best interests of the Village to keep, rendering it surplus property of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brownstown has determined that all property that cannot be sold at Village Hall by offering to the highest bidder thereon will be given to any residents willing to take the property or destroyed; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, after considerable thought and deliberation, has determined that it is in the best interests of the Village of Brownstown to convey this personal property as indicated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF BROWNSTOWN, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The above recitals are incorporated by reference herein as express findings of fact.

SECTION 2: The Personal Property indicated on Exhibit 1, is no longer useful for the Village or necessary for Village purposes and that it is in the best interests of the Village to dispose of the same;

<u>SECTION 3:</u> The personal property identified on Exhibit 1 is hereby declared surplus property of the Village of Brownstown, Illinois;

<u>SECTION 4:</u> The Village President and her designated agents are directed and authorized to dispose of the personal property;

<u>SECTION 5:</u> The Village President and her designated agents are directed and authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to convey said property as indicated.

<u>SECTION 6:</u> To the extent that any item, term or provision of this Ordinance and any contracts or agreements based on same shall be held to be unenforceable, void, or unconstitutional by a Court of law, said holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance and any contracts or agreements based on same.

<u>SECTION 7:</u> This Ordinance shall take effect from its adoption, execution and publication as provided for by law.
