**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BURLINGTON
AMENDING CHAPTER 395 "PARKS AND
RECREATION AREAS" TO CONTROL PARKING OF
VEHICLES AND TO PROVIDE FOR A MINIMUM
FINE OF ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS**

WHEREAS, to protect the public parks and recreation areas, and to preserve the existing parking in these areas, there is a need to enact additional regulations and to set a minimum fine for a violation.

BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Township Council of the Township of Burlington, County of Burlington, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section One. Code § 395-1 "Prohibited acts" is amended as follows:

- K. Drive and/or park a truck or commercial vehicle.
- L. Drive any automobile, van or sports utility vehicle, except on paved park roads, parking areas or such areas as may on occasion be specifically designated for temporary parking.
- M. Park any automobile, van or sports utility vehicle in other than an established or designated parking area, in accordance with posted directions and with the instruction of any attendant who may be present, or at night.

Section Two. Code § 395-5 "Violations and Penalties" is amended as follows:

A person violating any of the provisions of this chapter, or any rule or regulation promulgated pursuant hereto, and any person using a public park or recreation area without obtaining a required permit shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine not exceeding \$2,000, with a minimum fine of \$100, imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days or a period of community service not exceeding 90 days, or any combination thereof, and shall be responsible for the cost of the replacement, repair or restoration of any damaged property.

This Ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Township Council in the Township of Burlington held on June 27, 2023, and will be considered for final passage after a public hearing held at a Regular Meeting of the Township Council to be held on July 11, 2023, at the Township Municipal Building, Burlington Township, New Jersey at 7:00 p.m.

This will certify that the foregoing Ordinance was passed by a majority of the Burlington Township Council on July 11, 2023.
