**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BURLINGTON  
AMENDING CODE CHAPTER 275 "FIRE  
PREVENTION" SPECIFICALLY ARTICLE I "FIRE  
CONTROL MEASURES AND REGULATIONS" § 275-  
18 "STREET OBSTRUCTIONS" TO PROVIDE FOR  
ENFORCEMENT BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OR  
THE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND  
INSPECTION**

**WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Fire Prevention has requested that the street obstructions provisions of the Township Code set forth in § 275-18 be enforced by members of the Police Department and/or the Department of Licensing and Inspection.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED** by the Township Council of the Township of Burlington as follows:

**SECTION ONE.** Code § 275-18 is amended to add: "This section shall be enforced by members of the Police Department and/or the Department of Licensing and Inspection."

This Ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Township Council in the Township of Burlington held on February 13, 2024, and will be considered for final passage after a public hearing held at a Regular Meeting of the Township Council to be held on February 27, 2024, at the Township Municipal Building, Burlington Township, New Jersey at 7:00 p.m.
