ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BURLINGTON AMENDING TOWNSHIP CODE SECTION 15:1-2.2 "PARKING PROHIBITED" AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS" TO ADD A PORTION OF HANCOCK LANE TO SCHEDULE I

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety has recommended that no parking be permitted at any time along certain sections of Hancock Lane, between Bromley Boulevard and the municipal boundary with Westampton Township, as vehicles parking in these areas have created a public safety concern; and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this ordinance Schedule I of Code §15:1-2 will be amended to provide no parking at any time at the following locations along the easterly side of Hancock Lane:

- 1. From the municipal boundary line to the intersection with the southerly Tattersall Drive; and
- From the intersection of the southerly Tattersall Drive north 150 feet; and
- 3. From the intersection of the northerly Tattersall Drive south 150 feet; and
- 4. From the intersection of the northerly Tattersall Drive north 150 feet.

BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Township Council of the Township of Burlington, County of Burlington, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Schedule I of the Township Code §15:1-2 is amended to add no parking at any time along the easterly side of Hancock Lane at the following

locations:

- 1. From the municipal boundary line to the intersection with the southerly Tattersall Drive; and
- From the intersection of the southerly Tattersall Drive north 150 feet; and
- 3. From the intersection of the northerly Tattersall Drive south 150

feet; and

4. From the intersection of the northerly Tattersall Drive north 150

feet.

This Ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Township Council in the Township of Burlington held on April 9, 2024, and will be considered for final passage after a public hearing held at a Regular Meeting of the Township Council to be held on April 23, 2024, at the Township Municipal Building, Burlington Township, New Jersey at 7:00 p.m.

This will certify that the foregoing Ordinance was passed by a majority of the Burlington Township Council on April 23, 2024.
