ORDINANCE

AMENDING CODE SECTION 15:1-3 “LIMITING THE USE OF STREETS TO CERTAIN CLASS OF VEHICLES”, SPECIFICALLY SCHEDULE V TO EXCLUDE TRUCKS OVER FOUR (4) TONS GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT FROM PORTIONS OF BUSTLETON AND COLUMBUS ROADS

WHEREAS, in the interest of public safety, the County of Burlington has submitted, on behalf of Burlington Township, a request to the N.J. Department of Transportation to approve a 4-ton weight restriction on the section of Bustleton Road between Neck Road and the municipal boundary line with Florence Township, and the section of Columbus Road (C.R. 543) between the municipal boundary lines with both Burlington City and Florence Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Florence and the City of Burlington have each provided a resolution to the N.J. Department of Transportation in support of this request.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BURLINGTON, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Township Council hereby amends Code Section 15:1-3.1 and specifically Schedule V to prohibit commercial vehicles in excess of 4 tons gross vehicle weight (GVW) on the section of Bustleton Road between Neck Road and the municipal boundary line with Florence Township, and the section of Columbus Road (C.R. 543) between the municipal boundary lines with both Burlington City and Florence Township.

Section 2. Commercial vehicles exceeding the specified GVW are prohibited from using the designated streets or portions of streets, except for pick-up and delivery activities and exceptions that may apply as permitted by relevant laws and regulations.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law, and upon approval, where applicable, by the Burlington County Board of Commissioners, and by the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation, and publication required by law.

This Ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Township Council in the Township of Burlington held on April 28, 2026, and will be considered for final passage after a public hearing held at a Regular Meeting of the Township Council to be held on May 12, 2026, at the Township Municipal Building, Burlington Township, New Jersey at 7:00 p.m.

This will certify that the foregoing Ordinance was passed by a majority of the Burlington Township Council on May 12, 2026.
