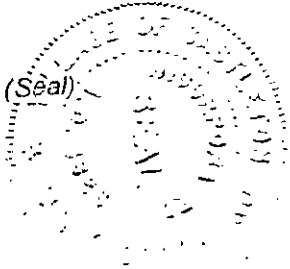

**LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 2020
OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLETON, NEW YORK**

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Castleton, the following:

§1 Purpose.

The purpose of this Article is to provide for the proper collection and disposal of garbage and recyclable materials in the Village.

§2 Duty of Owner or Occupant

It shall be the duty of the owner or occupant, in whole or in part, of any lot or part of a lot or building fronting upon any street in the village to, at all times, follow the below procedure for collection of garbage and recyclable materials:

- A. **Proper containers required.** All garbage and recyclable materials placed for collection and removal by residents shall be contained in closed containers provided by the Village and/or any third-party contractor for the Village. All garbage must be fully placed in such containers with the container lid completely closed.
- B. **Place of collection.** All garbage and recyclable materials to be collected shall be placed at the curbs of the village streets no earlier than eight hours prior to the day scheduled for collection, and , and all containers shall be removed from such curbs of the village streets eight hours after the day of such collection.
- C. To observe and obey any lawful resolution which may be passed by the Village Board with reference thereto and also to observe and obey and notice, printed or written, which may be served upon him by the Department of Public Works Superintendent or by the Code Enforcement Officer directing him to comply with all such duties and laws.

§3 Penalties

Failure to adhere to the above provisions by either the owner or occupant of a property shall be punishable by a fine of up to \$250 or imprisonment for a term not to exceed 15 days, or both fine and imprisonment as set forth in the Village of Castleton Code § 171-3. Nothing contained in this Article shall be construed to prevent the Village Board from ordering that the cost of any maintenance, clean-up, or removal of waste and garbage or garbage containers be paid by the violator(s) of the above law.

This law shall take effect upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State.
