**ORDINANCE NO. 1375**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CANONSBURG, COUNTY OF WASHINGTON, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 162 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, SECTION 16 ESTABLISHING ONE WAY STREETS AND CHAPTER 162, SECTION 33 PROHIBITED PARKING AT ALL TIMES.**

**WHEREAS**, Council for the Borough of Canonsburg (“Council”) has established various ordinances and Chapter 162 of its Code of Ordinance regulating traffic and vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Chapter 162 establishes certain streets within the Borough as being designated as one-way travel; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 33 of Chapter 162 prohibits parking at all times along certain streets within the Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, Council has determined that Section 16 and Section 33 of Chapter 162 requires an amendment to add Peach Alley to the list of one-way streets within the Borough and to prohibit parking along Peach Alley

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the Borough of Canonsburg, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 16 of Chapter 162 shall be amended as follows by adding the following street to the list of one-way streets.

§ 162-16 One-way Streets

A. The one-way streets previously enumerated in this section shall remain after amendment and the following street shall be added:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Limits</b>	<b>Direction of Travel</b>
Peach Alley	Cecil Street to Euclid Avenue	East

**Section 2.** Section 33 of Chapter 162 shall be amended as follows by adding the following street to the list of streets that parking is prohibited at all times.

§ 162-33 Parking Prohibited at All Times

A. The streets where parking shall be prohibited at all times, previously enumerated in this section shall remain after amendment and the following street shall be added:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>
Peach Alley	Both	Cecil Street to Euclid Avenue

**Section 3.** **Repealer.**

It is the intention of the Borough Council of the Borough of Canonsburg that all ordinances that are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. Further, any ordinance not specifically mentioned in this ordinance that is not in conflict with this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


**Section 4. Severability.**

If any portion of this ordinance is declared by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, it is the intention of the Council of the Borough of Canonsburg that all other parts remain in effect.


