ORDINANCE NO. 1377

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CANONSBURG, COUNTY OF
WASHINGTON, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING
CHAPTER 68 AMUSEMENT DEVICES, SECTION 68-5 FEES, OF THE
BOROUGH OF CANONSBURG CODE OF ORDINANCES.**

WHEREAS, Council of the Borough of Canonsburg (“Council”) has established various ordinances and Chapter 68 of its Code of Ordinances regulating amusement devices; and

WHEREAS, Section 68-5 establishes certain procedures and regulations mandating that annual license fees be paid in full by December 31 of each year; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is necessary to update these procedures and regulations regarding amusement device license fees.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Borough of Canonsburg, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

Section 1. Section 68-5(A) shall be amended as follows:

No license shall be issued until an annual fee, as set from time to time by resolution of the Borough Council, shall have been paid to the Borough of Canonsburg on or before June 30 of each year, for each and every mechanical or electronic device, machine or apparatus whatsoever and for each and every jukebox, music box, phonograph or other similar musical device, machine or apparatus so installed, used, played or operated in the Borough of Canonsburg. However, should any such aforesaid device be installed after June 30th of any year and an application therefore be made after said date, the annual fee shall be paid at the time of submittal of the application.

Section 2. Repealer.

It is the intention of Council of the Borough of Canonsburg that all ordinances that are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. Further, any ordinance or part of any ordinance not specifically mentioned in this ordinance that is not in conflict with this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Severability

If any portion of this ordinance is declared by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, it is the intention of the Council of the Borough of Canonsburg that all other parts remain in full force and effect.




