ORDINANCE NO. 1378

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CANONSBURG, COUNTY OF
WASHINGTON, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING
CHAPTER 144 SOLID WASTE, SECTION 144-5 STORAGE, OF THE
BOROUGH OF CANONSBURG CODE OF ORDINANCES.**

WHEREAS, Council of the Borough of Canonsburg (“Council”) has established various ordinances and Chapter 144 of its Code of Ordinances regulating the disposal of solid waste; and

WHEREAS, Section 144-5 establishes certain procedures and regulations that individuals must comply with regarding the disposal of solid waste; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is necessary to update these procedures and regulations in order to provide more adequate controls concerning when individuals place their containers out for collection.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Borough of Canonsburg, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

Section 1. Section 144-5(E)(6) shall be amended as follows:

With the exception of pickup days when containers are placed out for collection, the containers shall be properly stored on the owner or customer premises at all times. Containers shall not be placed out for collection prior to 6:00 p.m. the evening before pickup is to occur. Owners and customers shall remove containers that are placed out for collection and return them to their premises no later than 6:00 p.m. the day pickup is scheduled to occur.

Section 2. Repealer.

It is the intention of Council of the Borough of Canonsburg that all ordinances that are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. Further, any ordinance or part of any ordinance not specifically mentioned in this ordinance that is not in conflict with this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Severability

If any portion of this ordinance is declared by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, it is the intention of the Council of the Borough of Canonsburg that all other parts remain in effect.
