

CASCADE CHARTER TOWNSHIP

Ordinance #5 of 2023
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE #1 OF 2000
Liquor Licenses Ordinance

CASCADE CHARTER TOWNSHIP ORDAINS:

Section 5. Qualifications of applicant.

This section shall be amended to add section “L.,” and read as follows:

L. With respect to a person whose license is in escrow, whether owners of the escrowed license are in violation of any provision of this chapter, state law, other local ordinance or rule of the Michigan Liquor Control Commission, or if the license is held in escrow for more than one year.

Section 6. Prohibition on transfer as application requirement.

This section shall be amended to read as follows:

This article shall be known and referred to as “Prohibition on transfer as application requirement.”

The township shall not approve a class C liquor license for on premise consumption until the applicant executes and records a contract with the township prohibiting the sale or transfer of such license directly or through any escrow status and requires that the license be returned to the Michigan Liquor Control Commission upon sale or transfer of the business. Such contract shall provide for liquidated damages to the township and sanctions for any violation thereof to compensate the township for any reduction in the number of such licenses available within the township. Such contract shall provide for the forfeiture of the full sale or transfer price paid or payable to the transferor, together with interest on any unpaid balance, until the same is paid to the township. This subsection shall only apply to any licenses issued by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission that are subject to the Township’s applicable quotas.

Section 7. Location requirements.

This section shall be known and referred to as “Section 7.”

Section 8. Fines

This section shall be known and referred to as “Section 8.”

Section 9. Township Board rights; public hearing.

This section shall be known and referred to as “Section 9.”

Section 10. Objections to renewal and request for revocation.

This section shall be known and referred to as “Section 10.”

Section 11. Sunday sales of alcoholic beverages

This section shall be known and referred to as “Section 11.”

Section 12. Violations and penalties.

This section shall be known and referred to as “Section 12.”

Section 13. Previously licensed establishments.

This section shall be known and referred to as “Section 13.”
