**WHEREAS**, Local Law No. 2 for the year 2023 was presented to the Cayuga County Legislature on December 13, 2022; and,

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to law and after proper notice being duly given, the County Legislature held a public hearing on said Local Law No. 2 for 2023 on January 24, 2023 at 6:00 P.M.; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, that Local Law No. 2 of 2023, entitled “**LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR SALARY INCREASES FOR CERTAIN ELECTED COUNTY OFFICERS AND OFFICIALS APPOINTED FOR A FIXED TERM, DURING THEIR TERM**” as so designated, be and the same is hereby enacted, waiving any and all defects and informalities in the adoption thereof; and be it further.

LOCAL LAW NO. 2 FOR THE YEAR 2023

**A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR SALARY INCREASES FOR CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS AND OFFICIALS APPOINTED FOR A FIXED TERM, DURING THEIR TERM.**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the County Legislature of the County of Cayuga, as follows:

**Section 1.** The County of Cayuga will be considering resolutions to provide salary increases for non-bargaining employees and Department Heads of the County. It is the intent hereof to provide comparable increases for certain County Elected Officers and Officials appointed for a fixed term, during their term of office, in accordance with Section 201 of County Law.

**Section 2.** Effective January 1, 2023, the salary schedule for the following fixed-term positions shall be as follows:
