LOCAL LAW NO. 2 FOR THE YEAR 2023

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR SALARY INCREASES FOR CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS AND OFFICIALS APPOINTED FOR A FIXED TERM, DURING THEIR TERM.

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Cayuga, as follows:

Section 1. The County of Cayuga will be considering resolutions to provide salary increases for non-bargaining employees and Department Heads of the County. It is the intent hereof to provide comparable increases for certain County Elected Officers and Officials appointed for a fixed term, during their term of office, in accordance with Section 201 of County Law.

Section 2. Effective January 1, 2023, the salary schedule for the following fixed-term positions shall be as follows:


