LOCAL LAW NO. 2 FOR THE YEAR 2024

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR SALARY INCREASES FOR CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS APPOINTED FOR A FIXED TERM, DURING THEIR TERM.

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Cayuga, as follows:

Section 1. It is the intent hereof to provide increases for certain County Officers appointed for a fixed term, during their term of office, in accordance with § 201 of County Law.

Section 2. Effective January 1, 2024, the salary schedule for the following fixed-term offices shall be as follows:

<u>Office</u>	2024	2025	2026	2027
County Auditor 1/1/24 – 4 years	\$33/hr	\$34/hr	\$35/hr	\$36/hr

Section 3. The provisions of this Local Law are subject to a permissive referendum. This Local Law may take effect 45 days after its passage and subsequent filing with the New York State Department of State, provided that a referendum by electors is not required.

Section 4. The provisions of this Local Law are subject to permissive referendum.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)
