### ORDINANCE NO. 3.545

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CALIFORNIA, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY AND BARTLETT & WEST, INC., WHEREBY BARTLETT & WEST, INC. WOULD PERFORM ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE CITY, **RELATING TO THE INDUSTRIAL PARK WASTEWATER LIFTSTATION**

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF **CALIFORNIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. That the Contract (called "Agreement for Professional Services" attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully set forth) between the City of California, Missouri, a municipal corporation, and BARTLETT & WEST, INC., be and the same is hereby approved; the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract in multiple original for and on behalf of the City and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest such signature. Acts taken by City officials or employees in relation to the performance of this Contract are ratified.

#### **SECTION 2.** Safety Training Requirements.

a. The Project approved by this Ordinance is subject to the requirements of Section 292.675, RSMo, which requires all contractors or subcontractors doing work on the Project to provide, and require its on-site employees to complete, a ten (10) hour course in construction safety and health approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration ("OSHA") or a similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations which is at least as stringent as an approved OSHA program. The training must be completed within sixty (60) days of the date work on the Project commences. On-site employees found on the

worksite without documentation of the required training shall have twenty (20) days to produce such documentation.

b. The request for bids for this Project shall specify the requirements of Section 292.675, RSMo.

c. The contract awarded for this Project shall specify the requirements of Section 292.675, RSMo, and shall include a notice of the penalties for a contractor's failure to comply with that statute.

SECTION 3. That the acts taken by the Mayor or any representative or employee of the City with respect to the services to be rendered pursuant to the Contract are hereby ratified and approved.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. Further, copies of this ordinance having been made available for public inspection prior to the time the same is under consideration by the Board of Aldermen of the City of California, Missouri, and the title of the same having been read two times, this ordinance is
