

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CASSVILLE, MISSOURI, AMENDING SECTION 205.030 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODES**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cassville is a municipal corporation of the fourth class located in Barry County, Missouri, being duly created, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 205 of the municipal codes sets forth Animal Regulations within the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Aldermen desire to revise the municipal code so as to restrict the number of dogs and/or cats allowed at any one residence;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Cassville, County of Barry, State of Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 230.030 is amended to read as follows:

**Section 230.030 Number of Animals Allowed**

Except for kennels as regulated by the Zoning Codes of the City of Cassville, no person shall own, keep or harbor at their residence, more than four (4) dogs over the age of six (6) months or more than four (4) cats over the age of six (6) months.


Section 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon approval.
