ORDINANCE NO. 2024 - 1498

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF CARROLLTON TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GREEN HILLS REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE TERMS OF SUCH AGREEMENT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CARROLLTON as follows:

Section 1: The Council authorizes the Town to enter into an Agreement for grant writing, administrative services and environment review services with Green Hills Regional Planning Commission substantially in the form which is on file with the Town Clerk. The terms and provisions of the Agreement referenced are hereby approved and adopted by the Council of the Town of Carrollton, Missouri, on behalf of said Town. The amount of the lump sum bid was \$20,000.00. This selection is expressly contingent upon receipt of CDBG funding.

Section 2: The Council authorizes and directs the Mayor of the Town of Carrollton, Missouri to execute the Agreement and any documents the Mayor deems necessary or proper to carry out fully the terms of such Agreement. The Mayor, with the advice of the attorney acting for the Town, may make minor corrections and changes to the Agreement that does not affect the substance of the Agreement.


Section 3: The portions of this Ordinance shall be severable. In the event that any portion of this Ordinance is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the remaining portions of this Ordinance are valid, unless the court finds the valid portions of this Ordinance are so essential and inseparably connected with and dependent upon the void portion that it cannot be presumed that the Town Council would have enacted the valid portions without the invalid one, or unless the court finds that the valid portions standing alone are incomplete and are incapable of being executed in accordance with the legislative intent.

Section 4: This ordinance amends any prior ordinance or parts of any prior ordinance that might be in conflict herewith.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

A copy of this Ordinance has been made available for public inspection prior to its adoption by the Council and this bill was read by title in the open meeting two times prior to its final passage.

In addition, the cost of any *grant writing* and preliminary administration services must be separate and identifiable since these costs are not eligible for reimbursement from CDBG.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF CARROLLTON ACCEPTING THE BID AND AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ROAD SALT WITH
