A BILL TO CREATE AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED:

"AN ORDINANCE TO ADD THE SALE OF BULK WATER TO SECTION 26-118 E OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CENTRALIA, MO."

WHEREAS, The City of Centralia, MO deems it in the public interest and general welfare to provide a municipal distribution system for drinking water, and

WHEREAS, The Code of Ordinances of the City of Centralia, MO sets out policies and procedures for the utilities services,

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CENTRALIA, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 26 Article VI shall be amended to include a subsection 3 titled Bulk Water Sales.

Section 2. The new Section 26-118(3) shall read as follows:

Alderman Wilkins: Yes

- a. Requests for bulk water sales shall be submitted to the Utility Clerk on an application prepared by the City. Information shall include name of requestor, hydrant location where meter will be set, estimated water to be used, date meter needed, and contact information of the requestor.
- b. Sales of bulk water will be taken and prioritized at the discretion of the Director of Public Works.
- c. Requestors are required to deposit with the City prior to receipt of any bulk water request, the sum of \$127. This fee covers hydrant meter set up, up to 2000 gallons of water, and the City administrative fee.
- d. Any sale of bulk water in excess of 2000 gallons shall be billed at the rates outlined in section 26-118(a) and shall be collected at the time the hydrant meter is removed based on actual usage.

Alderman Deckerd: Yes

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Centralia, Missouri. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the terms hereof are void and of no effect.
