#### ORDINANCE NO. 2024-30

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CELINA, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CITY'S MASTER FEE CHART (APPENDIX A); PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF PREMISES; PROVIDING FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A CUMULATIVE REPEALER CLAUSE; **PROVIDING FOR SAVINGS**; PROVIDING **SEVERABILITY**; **PROVIDING FOR FOR** PENALTY, PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; PROVIDING FOR ENGROSSMENT AND ENROLLMENT; ANDPROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Celina is a home rule municipality located in Collin County and Denton County, Texas created in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Local Government Code, the Texas Constitution and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the state of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Celina, Texas is empowered under Local Government Code 54.001 to do all acts and make all regulations which may be necessary or expedient for the promotion of the public health, safety, and general welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is empowered to recover costs through the collection of various fees;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare that the City's fee schedule be revised.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CELINA, TEXAS

## SECTION 1 INCORPORATION OF PREMISES

The above and foregoing premises are true and correct and are incorporated herein and made a part hereof for all purposes.

### SECTION 2 FINDINGS

After due deliberations the City Council has concluded that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interest of the City of Celina, Texas and of the public health, safety, and welfare.

# SECTION 3 AMENDMENTS

- 3.01 That the City of Celina Code of Ordinances, Appendix A: <u>Master Fee Chart</u>, is hereby amended, in part, to read as contained in the attached Exhibit A.
- 3.02 All other articles, chapters, sections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases, and words are not amended and are hereby ratified and affirmed.

# SECTION 4 CUMULATIVE REPEALER CLAUSE

This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all other Ordinances and shall not repeal any of the provisions of such Ordinances except for those instances where there are direct conflicts with the provisions of this Ordinance. Ordinances, or parts thereof, in force at the time this Ordinance shall take effect and that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent with this Ordinance. Provided however, that any complaint, action, claim or lawsuit which has been initiated or has arisen under or pursuant to such other Ordinances on this date of adoption of this Ordinance shall continue to be governed by the provisions of such Ordinance and for that purpose the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

# SECTION 5 SAVINGS CLAUSE

All rights and remedies of the City of Celina, Texas are expressly saved as to any and all violations of the provisions of any other ordinance affecting utility rates and fees which have secured at the time of the effective date of this ordinance; and, as to such accrued violations and all pending litigation, both civil and criminal, whether pending in court or not, under such ordinances same shall not be affected by this Ordinance but may be prosecuted until final disposition by the court.

### SECTION 6 SEVERABILITY

The provisions of the Ordinance are severable. However, in the event this Ordinance or any procedure provided in this Ordinance becomes unlawful, or is declared or determined by a judicial, administrative or legislative authority exercising its jurisdiction to be excessive, unenforceable, void, illegal or otherwise inapplicable, in while in part, the remaining and lawful provisions shall be of full force and effect and the City shall promptly promulgate new revised provisions in compliance with the authority's decisions or enactment.

## SECTION 7 PENALTY

If the governing body of the City of Celina determines that a violation of this Ordinance has occurred, the City of Celina may bring suit in district court to enjoin the person, firm, partnership, corporation, or association from engaging in the prohibited activity. Any person, firm or corporation

violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance or of the Code of Ordinances as amended hereby, shall be subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Celina, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed upon each day during or on which a violation occurs and continues.

# SECTION 8 PUBLICATION CLAUSE

The City Secretary of the City of Celina is hereby directed to publish in the Official Newspaper of the City of Celina the Caption, and Effective Date Clause of this Ordinance as required by Section 52.013 of the Local Government Code.

### SECTION 9 ENGROSSMENT AND ENROLLMENT

The City Secretary is hereby directed to engross and enroll this Ordinance by copying the descriptive Caption in the minutes of the City Council and by filing this Ordinance in the Ordinance records of the City.

### SECTION 10 EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its date of passage in accordance with law.

- Governmental and public educational sites are exempt from all permit fees, false alarm charges, service fees, and fines that are assessed under this article as long as the entity has a valid alarm permit, but shall comply with all other requirements of this article.

<u>Temporary Water Service</u>: Temporary water service may be established at a residential structure for cleaning at the rate of \$15.00 per day, which includes services for seven (7) days or less for up to two-thousand gallons. The temporary connection service may be renewed in seven-day increments to a maximum of twenty-eight (28) consecutive days. Water consumed over two-thousand gallons will be billed at the regular volumetric rates.

<u>Bulk water sales</u>: Bulk water sales via a fire hydrant connection will be billed at the most current commercial rate. Anyone caught obtaining water without permission will be charged with a criminal offense.

## **Municipal Drainage Utility System Fees**

The drainage utility fee set forth in this section shall be collected through the city's bill for public utilities pursuant to the act

## **Impervious Area: Fee Assessed**

- Drainage utility fees shall be charged based on a property's contribution to the public drainage utility system. The contribution shall be based on the impervious area for the property.
- The drainage utility fee, payable monthly, shall be established with respect to all property within the City according to the following schedule

## **Impervious Exemptions**

- Property held and maintained in its natural state, until such time that the property is developed and all of the public infrastructure constructed has been accepted by the city in which the property is located for maintenance;
- A subdivided lot, until a structure has been built on the lot and a certificate of occupancy has been issued by the city;
- Property with proper construction and maintenance of a wholly sufficient and privately-owned drainage system;
  - State property;
  - City property;
  - County property;
  - School district property;
  - Tax-exempt religious institution property; and Public or private institutions of
  - higher education property.

#### **Pro-Rata Charges**

The rate of recovery will be calculated at the time of installation, however, will not exceed the actual amount of the line installed. The time period for recovery is five years past the date of the end of the maintenance bond.

#### **Impact Fees**

Impact fees for water and sewer service units shall be charged in accordance with the current impact fee ordinance.

#### **Repair Fees**

Repair to a city-owned infrastructure, including meters/components, will be charged to the party responsible for the damage or disruption of service. The fees associated with the repair

charge will be actual cost of materials, equipment, labor, and repair to streets and easements.

Review Fees for Permits - Individual wastewater discharge permit

A review fee and administration fee will be due at time of application in the amount of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500). No permit will be issued until this fee is paid by the applicant.
