

**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-33**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CELINA, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CELINA CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 12: TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE 12:03: OPERATION OF VEHICLES, DIVISION 2: TRAFFIC SCHEDULES, SECTION 12.03.051 SPEED LIMITS, TO ADD SCHOOL ZONE LOCATIONS; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF PREMISES; PROVIDING FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A CUMULATIVE REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR SAVINGS; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR ENGROSSMENT AND ENROLLMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Celina is a home rule municipality located in Collin County and Denton County, Texas created in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Local Government Code, the Texas Constitution and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the state of Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 541.302(13) of the Texas Transportation Code defines a "school crossing zone" as a reduced-speed zone designated on a street by a local authority to facilitate safe crossing of the street by children going to or leaving a public or private elementary or secondary school during the time the reduced speed limit applies; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 545.356 of the Texas Transportation Code provides that whenever the governing body of a municipality shall determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that any prima facie speed limit is unreasonable or unsafe on a street or portion thereof within the municipality, taking into consideration the width and condition of the pavement, the usual traffic at the affected area, and other circumstances, the governing body may alter by ordinance the prima facie speed limit established by State law and determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit upon that street or portion thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, due to new school construction the City Council hereby finds it necessary to provide for additional school zones within the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CELINA, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1**  
**INCORPORATION OF PREMISES**

The above and foregoing premises are true and correct and are incorporated herein and made a part hereof for all purposes.

**SECTION 2**  
**FINDINGS**

After due deliberations the City Council has concluded that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the City of Celina, Texas, and of the public health, safety and welfare.

**SECTION 3**  
**AMENDMENT**

3.01 The Celina Code of Ordinances, Chapter 12: Traffic and Vehicles; Article 12.03: Operation of Vehicles; Division 2: Traffic Schedules; Section 12.03.051: Speed limits; subsection 12.03.051(a): School zones is hereby amended to read as provided in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

3.02 All other articles, chapters, sections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases and words are not amended but are hereby ratified and affirmed.

**SECTION 4**  
**CUMULATIVE REPEALER CLAUSE**

This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all other Ordinances and shall not repeal any of the provisions of such Ordinances except for those instances where there are direct conflicts with the provisions of this Ordinance. Ordinances, or parts thereof, in force at the time this Ordinance shall take effect and that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent with this Ordinance. Provided however, that any complaint, action, claim or lawsuit which has been initiated or has arisen under or pursuant to such other Ordinances on the date of adoption of this Ordinance shall continue to be governed by the provisions of such Ordinance and for that purpose the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 5**  
**SAVINGS CLAUSE**

All rights and remedies of the City of Celina, Texas are expressly saved as to any and all violations of the provisions of any other ordinance affecting traffic and vehicles within the City of Celina, which have secured at the time of the effective date of this Ordinance; and, as to such accrued violations and all pending litigation, both civil and criminal, whether pending in court or not, under such ordinances same shall not be affected by this Ordinance but may be prosecuted until final disposition by the court.

**SECTION 6**  
**PENALTY CLAUSE**

Any person violating this Ordinance or the requirements to obey traffic control devices contained in the Texas Transportation Code and other applicable law shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in accordance with penalties prescribed by the Texas Transportation Code and the City's Code of Ordinances. Each occurrence in violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.

**SECTION 7**  
**SEVERABILITY**

If any section, article, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word in this Ordinance, or

application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance, and the City Council hereby declares it would have passed such remaining portions of the Ordinance despite such invalidity, which remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 8**  
**ENGROSSMENT AND ENROLLMENT**

The City Secretary of the City of Celina is hereby directed to engross and enroll this Ordinance by copying the exact Caption and Effective Date clause in the minutes of the City Council of the City of Celina and by filing this Ordinance in the Ordinance records of the City.

**SECTION 9**  
**OPEN MEETINGS**


That it is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public as required by law, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code

**SECTION 10**  
**EFFECTIVE DATE**

**This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and publication as required by law.**


