## VILLAGE OF CHITTENANGO

**LOCAL LAW NO. 6-2023** 

A Local Law Amending Chapter 142 of the Village of Chittenango Code to Designate North Street as a One-Way Street

Be it enacted by the Village of Chittenango, as follows:

### Section I

In accordance with Section 142-5 of the Village of Chittenango Code, Section 142-29 of the Code titled "Schedule II: One-Way Streets," is hereby amended to designate a portion of North Street as one-way as follows:

### **Section II**

This Local Law shall take effect upon its filing with the New York Secretary of State.
