Chapter 45

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF CHELMSFORD TO CONTINUE THE EMPLOYMENT OF FIRE CHIEF MICHAEL CURRAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Michael Curran, chief of the fire department of the town of Chelmsford, may continue to serve in that position until June 30, 2015, until the date of his retirement or until the date he is relieved of his duties by the town manager, whichever occurs first; provided, however, that he is mentally and physically capable of performing the duties of his office. The board of selectmen of the town of Chelmsford, at its own expense, may require that Michael Curran be examined by an impartial physician designated by the board to determine his mental and physical capability. No further deductions shall be made from the regular compensation of Michael Curran under chapter 32 of the General Laws for any service subsequent to July 18, 2013, and upon retirement, he shall receive a superannuation retirement allowance equal to that which he would have been entitled had he retired on July 18, 2013.
