ORDINANCE NO. 2021- 218

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CHARLESTOWN CODE OF
ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 15, REGULATING TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN
ROADS WITHIN CHARLESTOWN TOWNSHIP

BE IT HEARBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of
Charlestown Township, Chester County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as follows:

Section 1. The Charlestown Code of Ordinances, Chapter 15, Traffic Regulations,
§201 is hereby amended to change the following street speed limit identified in the Code:

§15-201. 1. Maximum speed limits are established on portions of specified streets,
as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on any part of a street where
a maximum speed limit applies at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for the part of the
street:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Maximum Speed Limit</u>
Wells Road	Entire Length	25 mph

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall be effective five (5) days from the
date of enactment.


