

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 349 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CLIFTON, ENTITLED "PARKING ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS," MORE PARTICULARLY SECTION 349-1 THEREOF, ENTITLED "DESIGNATION OF RESTRICTED STREETS; ISSUANCE OF PERMITS" (ESTABLISHES PROCESS TO RESCIND PERMIT PARKING)**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Municipal Council of the City of Clifton, that:

1. Chapter 349 of the Code of the City of Clifton, entitled "Parking on Residential Streets," more particularly Section 349-1 thereof, entitled "Designation of restricted streets; issuance of permits," is hereby amended, revised and supplemented as follows:

**Chapter 349**

**PARKING ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS**

**ARTICLE I**

**Residential Streets**

**§ 349-1. Designation of restricted streets; issuance of permits.**

**E. Withdrawal of permit parking.**

1. The Chief of Police will accept petitions for withdrawal of permit parking in a form promulgated by the Chief of Police or his designee, signed by representatives of at least 60% of property owners located in a permit parking area designated in § 349-2. Upon receipt of a qualifying petition, the Chief of Police or his designee shall conduct a study for the purpose of determining if it is no longer necessary for a designated area to have permit parking and make a recommendation to the City Council accordingly. The City Council may at any time initiate its own action to withdraw permit parking in an area, without the necessity of following these procedures.

2. Petitions shall be signed by one person with an ownership interest in a single-family residence or by one person with an ownership interest representing all of the tenants in a multifamily structure. The address of each petitioner must be shown.

3. Upon action by the City Council withdrawing permit parking in a designated area, written notice of such action shall be sent to each holder of a parking permit in that area.

2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistency only.

3. This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.
