

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 11 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CLIFTON, ENTITLED "ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON CIVIL RIGHTS" MORE PARTICULARLY SECTION 11-2 THEREOF ENTITLED "MEMBERSHIP; TERMS OF OFFICE"

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Council of the City of Clifton, that:

1. Chapter 11 of the Code of the City of Clifton, entitled "Advisory Committee on Civil Rights" is hereby amended, revised and supplemented to read as follows:

CHAPTER 11

ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON CIVIL RIGHTS

Section 11-1. Creation; title.

Section 11-2. Membership; terms of office.

A. The Committee shall consist of up to 32 members to be appointed by the Municipal Council, three appointed Councilmembers and the City Manager. The three Councilmembers and City Manager shall be non-voting members. To the greatest extent possible, every effort shall be made to have a representative from each of the following contiguous neighborhoods within the City on the Committee: Albion, Allwood, Athenia, Botany/East, Clifton Center/Middle Village, Delawanna, Dutch Hill, Greglawn, Hazel, Knollwood, Lakeview, Maple Valley, Montclair Heights, Oakridge, Richfield and Rosemawr.

B. The term of each member shall be two years. In the event that a vacancy occurs, the vacancy shall be filled by the Municipal Council for the unexpired balance of the term. Members may be reappointed to the Committee by the Municipal Council to serve a second two-year term.
