

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 439 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CLIFTON, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," MORE PARTICULARLY SECTION 439-14 THEREOF, ENTITLED "PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS/DAYS ON CERTAIN STREETS (ELIMINATES HOURLY PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON MCCOSH ROAD BECAUSE IT IS ALREADY COVERED BY PERMIT PARKING)

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Council of the City of Clifton, that:

1. Chapter 439 of the Code of the City of Clifton, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic," more particularly Section 439-14 thereof, entitled "Parking prohibited during certain hours/days on certain streets," be and the same is hereby revised to remove the following locations:

Chapter 439
VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Article II.
Stopping, Standing and Parking

§ 439-14. **Parking prohibited during certain hours/days on certain streets.**

No person shall park a vehicle between the hours listed and/or the days specified upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:

Name of Street	Side	Hours/Days	Location
McCosh Road (Northern Portion)	East	8:00 a.m. to 5:00p.m./ Tues. And Thurs.	From Woodlawn Ave to Edwards Road
McCosh Road (Northern Portion)	West	8:00 a.m. to 5:00p.m./ Mon., Wed., Fri.	From Woodlawn Ave to Hibben Place
McCosh Road (Southern Portion)	East	8:00 a.m. to 11:00a.m./ Tues. And Thurs.	From Normal Ave to Woodlawn Ave
McCosh Road (Southern Portion)	West	8:00 a.m. to 11:00a.m./ Mon., Wed., and Fri.	From Normal Ave to Woodlawn Ave

- The Chief of Police is hereby directed to install and/or remove signs and/or markings calling attention to the within ordinance.
- Any ordinance or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistency only.
- This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law, and upon approval of the County of Passaic.
