

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE, AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 43 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CLIFTON ENTITLED "ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES" AT § 43-2 "MEMBERSHIP, TERMS OF OFFICE" (ADDS TWO ALTERNATE MEMBERS TO THE COMMITTEE)

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Council of the City of Clifton, that:

1. Chapter 43 of the Code of the City of Clifton, as titled above, is hereby amended, revised and supplemented to read as follows:

Chapter 43

Advisory Committee for Individuals With Disabilities

§ 43-2 Membership; terms of office.

- A. The Committee shall consist of nine members to be appointed by the Municipal Council. The term of each member shall be four years. In the event that a vacancy occurs, the same shall be filled by the Municipal Council for the unexpired balance of the term.
- B. The Municipal Council shall appoint two alternate members in addition to the nine regular members. The alternate members shall be designated at the time of appointment as "Alternate No. 1" and "Alternate No. 2." The term of each alternate member shall be four years. In the event that a vacancy occurs, the same shall be filled by the Municipal Council for the unexpired balance of the term. An alternate member may participate in discussions of the proceedings but may not vote except in the absence or disqualification of a regular member. A vote shall not be delayed in order that a regular member may vote instead of an alternate member. In the event that a choice must be made as to which alternate member is to vote, Alternate No. 1 shall vote first.
- C. The Committee shall be composed of persons with disabilities and/or persons interested in matters affecting individuals with disabilities.

2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistency only.

3. This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as provided by law.
