

**CORBIN CITY
ORDINANCE NO. 8-2023**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AND ESTABLISHING SALARY RANGES
OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF CORBIN CITY, COUNTY OF
ATLANTIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY FOR THE YEAR 2023**

SECTION 1: The salary ranges for officers and employees of the City of Corbin City shall be as listed below:

The following salaries, wages and compensation shall be paid to the following officials and employees of the City of Corbin City and shall be paid to all those employed at the time of passing of this Ordinance who have been continuously employed since January 1, 2023 or thereafter on a retroactive basis as stated in the annual salary resolution, appointing resolutions or personal services agreement.

Section 2: All salaries and wages as listed in Section 1 shall be paid bi-weekly and shall be paid in installments on a monthly or semi-annual basis, by resolution of the City Council.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be effective after final passage and publication as provided by law.
