§ 270-18 On-street parking of Construction Vehicles and Equipment.

[Added 5-23-2016 by L.L. No. 5-2016; amended 8-27-2018 by L.L. No. 5-2018]

A. The following regulations apply to a permit for parking or placement of construction vehicles, trailers, lifts, and dumpsters in the Village of Cooperstown in the public right-of-way, including on streets and, when appropriate, sidewalks.

B. A parking permit for construction vehicles and equipment is hereby established in accordance with the following regulations:

(1) A Construction Vehicle, for the purpose of this section, is a motor vehicle licensed for operation on public highways by the State of New York that is required at a job site for use in construction, repair and maintenance, demolition, or storage of materials, tools, or equipment. For the purposes of this section, a licensed motor vehicles that is primarily used for commuting to a job site is not a Construction Vehicle, may not obtain or display a Construction Vehicle parking permit, and is subject to all Village parking laws.

(2) Application for a Construction Vehicle permit will include the name of the contracting company, vehicle owner(s), the name and cell phone number of the individual who will be responsible for the vehicle at the job site, and the license plate number(s) of the vehicle(s).

(3) Each vehicle will display a Construction Vehicle permit on the driver's side dashboard of the vehicle.

(4) There will be a fee as established by the Board of Trustees for a Construction Vehicle permit.

(5) A Construction Vehicle permit will be valid for a period of three years from date of issue.

(6) Permits are available for purchase on weekdays during normal business hours.

(7) The Construction Vehicle permit is valid only for the specific vehicle for which it is issued except that permits may be transferable between vehicles owned by the same company or by partners in an LLC, provided identifying information is submitted for all vehicles.

C. A permit to place Construction Equipment within the public right-of-way is established with the following regulations:

(1) Construction Equipment includes any trailer, lift, storage structure, dumpster, or similar item required at a job site for use in construction, repair and maintenance, demolition, or storage of materials, tools, or equipment.

(2) Application for a Construction Equipment permit will include the name of the contracting company, equipment owner(s), the name and cell phone number of the individual who will be responsible for the equipment at the job site, and a description of the equipment. The application will additionally include the location of the job, expected duration of the job, and indication of space needed.

(3) Each piece of equipment will display a Construction Equipment permit, valid only for the period of work and for a designated location.

(4) There will be a fee as established by the Board of Trustees based on the location, duration of use, and amount of space required.

(5) Permits are available for purchase on weekdays during normal business hours.

(6) The permit for Construction Equipment is valid only for the specific item for which it is issued.

(9) Cones may only be used for safety reasons or to preserve a designated space for equipment at a job site.

D. Violations of the provisions of this section are subject to a fine of \$75 for a first offense and a one-year (calendar-year) suspension of the Construction Vehicle or Construction Equipment permit for the vehicle for a second offense. Violations shall include:

(1) Giving false information about the location and/or duration of work.

(2) Displaying a Construction Vehicle or Construction Equipment permit at any location that is not a job site.
