

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-13-2019-01 (UPPER SCOTTS RUN  
SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION)**

A RESOLUTION OF THE COLLIER TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY (CTMA)  
AGREEING TO ACCEPT OWNERSHIP OF CERTAIN SANITARY SEWERS AND  
MANHOLES AS INSTALLED AND CONSTRUCTED BY THE COLLIER TOWNSHIP  
MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY FOR THE UPPER SCOTTS RUN SANITARY SEWER  
EXTENSION

WHEREAS, CTMA as the project developer, has caused to be constructed, certain sanitary sewers, manholes and associated main line components necessary for the UPPER SCOTTS RUN SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION; and,

WHEREAS, CTMA awarded the necessary contracts for the construction and installation of the system by and through W. A. Petrakis Contracting Company; and,

WHEREAS, field observations of construction of sanitary sewers and manholes were performed by NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc. on behalf of the Collier Township Municipal Authority; and,

WHEREAS, NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc., on June 13, 2019, verbally advised the Collier Township Municipal Authority that final inspection and testing of the sanitary sewer lines within project extension area are complete; and,

WHEREAS, the sanitary sewer lines and manholes previously have passed the required air

and vacuum tests and passed the necessary deflection (mandrel) test; and,

WHEREAS, the following described lines and manholes have now passed the required mandrel testing and the required air testing of approximately 9,460 lineal feet of 8”diameter PVC pipe, 750.5 lineal feet of 10” diameter PVC pipe, (64) 4’ diameter precast concrete manholes, (2) 5’ diameter precast concrete manholes, (48) 8” x 6” service lines wye connections and 861 lineal feet of 6”diameter PVC service line laterals, all as shown in as built plans and specifications and all with all testing being verified and approved by NIRA Consulting Engineers; and,

WHEREAS, NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc. recommended that the sewer lines listed in the attached exhibit sheet be accepted by the Collier Township Municipal Authority; and,

WHEREAS, W. A. Petrakis Contracting Company now has provided to the Collier Township Municipal Authority its certification as to the construction cost of the said lines which were constructed at a construction cost of \$1,037,069.00; and,

WHEREAS, W. A. Petrakis Contracting Company has posted the required maintenance bond in the amount of one hundred (100%) percent of the Contract price and said bond to run for a period of two years which bond will be dated June 21, 2019.

NOW THEREFORE, the Collier Township Municipal Authority at a publicly held meeting on the 13th day of June 2019 authorized the preparation of a written resolution that would formally adopt the construction of this project and now:

1. Reviewed this Resolution, and formerly adopted the Resolution, accepting ownership and control of the sanitary sewer lines and manholes listed in the attached exhibit as of the date of this Resolution.

2. The lines and manholes hereby accepted located in and through within the Upper Scotts Run sanitary basin and are added to the CTMA sanitary sewer system now and into the future.
3. This Resolution of acceptance of these public improvements shall be maintained as part of the records of the Collier Township Municipal Authority and a copy shall be delivered to W. A. Petrakis Contracting Company.
4. As part of this acceptance, W. A. Petrakis Contracting Company is to provide two (2) sets of As-Built Reproducible Drawings and one (1) DVD electronic copy of the sanitary sewers as accepted. Additionally, W. A. Petrakis Contracting Company, has provided s a Bill of Sale conveying the sanitary sewer main line and manholes to CTMA for the consideration of one (\$1.00) dollar.
5. This Resolution now directs that a notice to connect to the now available sanitary sewer lines constructed as part of this project be sent by certified mail to each property owner whose property was served by this construction that they are required to connect to this public sanitary sewer project within ninety days of the mailing of the notice to connect.

Formally adopted this 11th day of July 2019, by a majority vote of the members of the Collier Township Municipal Authority.
