

**TOWNSHIP OF COLLIER
ORDINANCE NO. 730**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF COLLIER AMENDING
CHAPTER 15, SECTION 406, OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF
ORDINANCES TO PROHIBIT THE OVERNIGHT PARKING OF NON
PASSENGER VEHICLES ON TOWNSHIP STREETS**

I. Legislative Findings of Fact:

The Board of Commissioners of Collier Township has received complaints regarding the parking of commercial and oversized vehicles on Township streets overnight and wishes to address those concerns.

II. The Board of Commissioners of Collier Township hereby ordains as follows:

1. Chapter 15, § 406, Parking of Trucks, Buses and Certain Other Vehicles Prohibited in Certain Locations is amended by repealing the current title and content of that section and replacing it with the following:

Chapter 15, § 406, Parking of Trucks, Buses and Certain Other Vehicles Prohibited During Certain Times.

- A. Between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., Monday through Saturday, and from 10:00 p.m. Saturday to 6:00 a.m. Monday, it shall be unlawful for any person to park, or allow to remain parked, any vehicle other than a passenger car on any street in the Township of Collier, this includes a prohibition on the overnight parking of any bus, motorhome, trailer or boat.
- B. Exceptions. Nothing in Subsection A of this section shall prevent any commercial vehicle, mechanized machinery, or equipment, while engaged in work and/or construction for Collier Township, utility companies, or private contractor, with the permission of the Township Manager or representative, from parking on or in any highway of the Township of Collier during the restricted hours. Vehicles otherwise prohibited may park during restricted hours for the prompt loading and unloading of the same.
- III. It is the intention of the Township of Collier that the provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any provisions of this Ordinance are held or declared illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the decision shall not effect or impair any of the remaining section.
- IV. Any ordinance or resolution inconsistent with this Ordinance is repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- V. This Ordinance is effective upon recordation in the Township Ordinance Book.
