AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF CITY OF COOL VALLEY, MISSOURI, FOR THEIR APPROVAL AT GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY ON 5TH DAY OF APRIL, 2016, A PROPOSITION TO AUTHORIZE THE TO CONTINUE APPLYING AND COLLECTING THE LOCAL SALES TAX ON THE TITLING OF MOTOR VEHICLES, TRAILERS, BOATS AND OUTBOARD MOTORS THAT WERE PURCHASED FROM A SOURCE OTHER THAN A LICENSED MISSOURI DEALER.

WHEREAS, the City of Cool Valley, Missouri currently applies and collects tax on the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and outboard motor purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri Dealer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 32.087, RSMo., the City must submit to the qualified voters of the City, the question of continuing or repealing the application of the local sales tax on the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and outboard motors that were purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer; and

WHEREAS, rejection of this measure will result in a reduction of local services provided for vital services for the City of Cool Valley; and

WHEREAS, it will place Missouri dealers of motor vehicles, outboard motors, trailers, boats, and trailers at a competitive disadvantage to non-Missouri dealers of motor vehicles, outboard motors, boats, and trailers; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen believes that such a proposition should be placed on the ballot at the April 5, 2016, General Municipal Election.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF COOL VALLEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One

That as required by the provisions of § 32.087, RSMo., there shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the City of Cool Valley, Missouri, for their approval, at the next municipal election to be held on April 5, 2016, the ballot submission, which shall contain substantially the following language:

Proposition V

Shall the City of Cool Valley, Missouri continue applying and collecting local sales tax on the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and outboard motors that were purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer?

motors that were purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer? Rejection of this measure will result in a reduction of local revenue to provide for vital services for the City of Cool Valley, Missouri and place Missouri dealers of motor vehicles, outboard motors, boats and trailers at a competitive disadvantage to non-Missouri dealers of motor vehicles, outboard motors, boats, and trailers.

Section Two

The City Clerk shall prepare and cause to be forwarded to the Board of Election Commissioners of St. Louis County, Missouri, a Notice of Election in compliance with this ordinance and take such other steps as may be required so that an election can be lawfully conducted.

Section Three


The Board of Election Commissioners of St. Louis County shall conduct such election according to the law and certify the results thereof. The Board of Election Commissioners shall designate such polling places as shall be required for such election and shall appoint such necessary election officials as may be required for such election thereof. The Board of Election Commissioners shall also publish such notice of election as shall be required by law and shall do and perform such other necessary duties as may be required to conduct such election in accord with the statutes of Missouri and the ordinances of the City of Cool Valley, Missouri.

Section Four

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen.
