## b. Discussion Group Updates (Maria, Lisa, Aliyah, Michael, Sherry)

- (1) Black History Month: Its origins, objectives and future. The discussion was held 2/10/21 with a good turnout and great discussion. For those of you who were not able to attend, the suggested readings are posted and are worth reading.
  - (a) Report on Feb meeting, including new initiative that came up for ways for the Village to commemorate any diverse heritages, in particular Lorraine Hansberry who lived here and is buried in Bethel Cemetery;
  - (b) We discussed outreach to the Village's new Arts and Humanities Committee (Alex Dyer, chair) to collaborate on celebrating Lorraine Hansberry (and other black authors). Sherry offered to contact Alex Dyer. Perhaps a joint meeting of the A&H and D&I committees on this topic can be arranged. Who will champion this effort?

- (2) For March hoping to have a session.TBD. New permanent date will be 4yh Tuesday of the month; Fred Opie status (John H if he's in attendance), and a call for participation and facilitators. (Michael/Sherry/MMS/Aliyah(?)
  - (a) After discussion with Fred Opie, we decided to push his presentation to November to coincide with Croton Free Library's annual fundraiser. Or will it be the Lorraine Hansberry Free Library?! (e.g. Desmond Fish Library in Garrison, etc).
  - (b) For March, the Discussion Group will take place on March 16, 7pm via Village Zoom channel. Per Maria, the topic will be an overview of systemic racism as background for a series across upcoming months of discussion groups on more specific topics such as impact of systemic racism on economics & wealth distribution, education, housing, etc.
- (3) For April, the tentative discussion topic will be "Racism, wealth and housing."
- (4) For May, we plan a presentation on Asian-Pacific American Experience (Michael Mui). It is also Jewish-American Experience Month. We could have 45 minutes on former and 45 minutes on latter for this discussion group. We should decide this by time of next month's meeting.

They carefully review suggestions and write a short capsule summary of each title on the list that is published in advance of the Discussion Group date.

In order to accommodate additional suggestions from the participants, Amy's team will prepare a short "checklist" of criteria that those individuals should meet in recommending a resource (they should have read it themselves; it should be well researched, and truly a book or article the recommender really likes.)
