1. Introduction and Opening Business (5min)

- a. Health and Welfare check of members
- b. Introduction of potential new members/guests: Nancy Libow, Kat Randel, Beth McFadden.
- c. Leadership Transition
 - Maria has agreed to serve through the end of this year. Discussion is needed as to the future of the Committee how to continue if no one steps forward.
- d. Approval of minutes of Sept 28, 2021 unanimously approved.

2. Administration (5-10 min)

There are likely many people who will be interested in something, but may not want the responsibility of being member, ie meetings, required classes, etc.
- d. Amy expressed the large amount of work required to review and come up with the list of book recommendations and perhaps there could be a new way going forward for the Library to be involve that is less work intensive.
