ORDINANCE NO. 26-37-1693

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 189 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF CRESSKILL, TITLED "PARKING" BY ADDING NEW SECTIONS 189-8 THROUGH 189-13

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Cresskill that Chapter 189 of the Borough Code, titled " Parking" is hereby amended by adding new Section 189-8 through Section 189-13 to read as follows:

Section 1

§ 189-8 General parking regulations for all Borough lots, including the lots located on Allen Street, Spring Street, 3rd Street, Crestron Field and at the Library.

- A. There shall be no parking permitted for longer than 24 consecutive hours in any Borough lot except as specifically set forth in Section 189-9 allowing permit parking at the Allen Street lot.
- B. Vehicles shall be removed whenever snow has fallen, and the accumulation is such that it covers the pavement. These parking prohibitions shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased, until the parking lot has been plowed sufficiently after the snow event has ended.
- C. Parking may also be prohibited or further restricted on a temporary basis, at the direction of the Chief of Police or his or her designee, provided notice of such temporary prohibition or restriction are prominently noticed at the parking lot.
- D. Notice of the parking prohibition contained herein shall be given by the posting of signs in all areas where parking is restricted.

§ 189-9 Allen Street parking lot

- A. No person shall park a vehicle at any time at the Allen Street parking lot in the parking spaces reserved for residents unless the vehicle displays the proper permit issued by the Borough. Decals will be available at the office of the Borough Clerk for those who qualify at a cost of \$100.00 per year. The decal will be for a period from January 1 through December 31. Residents whose Block 74 with Lots 40, 42, 45, 46, 47 and 47.01 shall be entitled to purchase a minimum of one permit per dwelling unit. If additional permits are available, they will be offered to the same residents.
- B. Vehicles displaying the proper permit are not subject to the time restriction set forth in § 189-8 A. provided they are in the designated parking spaces.

§ 189-10

- A. All of the parking spaces on Allen Street are reserved for residents of Cresskill. As set forth in Exhibit "A" four (4) spaces are reserved for the residents of Block 74, Lot 42, three (3) spaces are reserved for Block 74 Lot 45 and four (4) spaces are reserved for Block 74 lot 46.. The remaining dedicated spaces are reserved for residents of Cresskill whose Block 74 with Lots 40, 47 and 47.0. Decals will be available at the office of the Borough Clerk for those who qualify, at a cost of \$100.00-per year. The decal will be for a period from January 1 through December 31.

§ 189-11

Parking is prohibited in the Allen Street parking lot between the hours of 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. This restriction shall not apply to any space dedicated to residents pursuant to §189-9A.

§ 189-12

There shall be a two (2) hour limit to parking on Union Avenue.

§ 189-13 Violation and Penalties

A. Any person or entity who violates any provision of this chapter shall be punished by a fine in the amount set forth in the Violations Bureau Schedule of the Municipal Court of Cresskill, or, where no amount is set forth, a fine not exceeding \$1,250. Each day a provision of this chapter is violated shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.

B. In addition to the foregoing penalties, the municipality may enforce the provisions of this chapter by having any vehicles found to be in violation towed, at the registered owner's expense.

Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
