

ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Sherman Street, between North Main Street and First Street is a two lane street in the CITY OF CRYSTAL LAKE with parking permitted on both sides of the street; and

WHEREAS, allowing vehicles to park on both sides results in difficulty for larger vehicles such as school buses, delivery vehicles and snow plows to travel along this section of Sherman Street;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRYSTAL LAKE, as follows:

SECTION I: That it shall be unlawful to stop, stand, or park any vehicle on the north side of Sherman Street from N. Main Street to First Street.

SECTION II: That any person, firm, or corporation violating any provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined in accordance with Chapter 1, Article II providing for General Penalty Provision in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Crystal Lake, Illinois.

SECTION III: That suitable signs and markers shall be erected.

SECTION IV: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval according to law.

SECTION V: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
