AN ORDINANCE APPROVING PURCHASE ORDERS TO REPLACE THE PLAYGROUND STRUCTURE AND RESURFACE THE PLAYGROUND AT FERNDALE PARK, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Crestwood (the "City") planned on resurfacing the playground at Ferndale Park; and

WHEREAS, the playground structure is also in need of updating, and to replace the structure at a later date would require the City to tear up any resurfacing done now; and

WHEREAS, Play & Park Structures has offered the City a new playground system at a discounted price if the system is replaced at the time of the resurfacing; and

WHEREAS, the City's Purchasing Policy authorizes purchases through national, state, or local level cooperative purchasing programs, which includes TIPS-USA (the "Program"); and

WHEREAS, City staff has found the costs obtained from Play & Park Structures and Pro-Tech Surfacing LLC pursuant to the Program for replacing and resurfacing the playground at Ferndale Park (the "Project") to be reasonable: and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen deems the Project necessary and budgeted funds for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CRESTWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Board of Aldermen herby approves: 1) a purchase order with Play & Park Structures for the playground structure portion of the Project, including installation, in an amount not to exceed Fifty One Thousand Four Hundred Fifty Four Dollars (\$51,454.00); and 2)

a purchase order with Pro-Tech Surfacing LLC for the playground resurfacing in an amount not to exceed Thirty-Five Thousand Two Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$35,200.00).

<u>SECTION 2:</u> The City Administrator, or his designated representative, is hereby authorized to approve and execute change orders in the event of contingencies or additional work related to the purchase orders as authorized pursuant to the City's Purchasing Policy.

SECTION 3: The Mayor, City Administrator and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the purchase orders on behalf of the City and to take such other actions as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the intent and purposes of this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen and its approval by the Mayor.
