ORDINANCE NO. 5434

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2024  
CHEVROLET SILVERADO 1500 TRUCK IN A TOTAL SUM NOT TO  
EXCEED FORTY-TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND FIFTY-ONE  
DOLLARS (\$42,451.00), AND DESIGNATING AN EXISTING FORD  
FUSION AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF  
THE SURPLUS EQUIPMENT

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WHEREAS, the City of Crestwood (the “City”) Department of Public Works (the “Department”) has requested the authority to purchase a new 2024 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 Work Truck that will be used by the Public Works Street Maintenance team; and

WHEREAS, the new truck will replace the 2016 Ford Explorer reserved for the Superintendent of Streets, and the 2016 Ford Explorer will become the new administrative staff car replacing the existing Ford Fusion which is at the end of its service life; and

WHEREAS, the Department recommends designating the Ford Fusion as surplus property;  
and

WHEREAS, the City’s Ways and Means Committee budgeted monies for the purchase of a new, replacement vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Purchasing Policy authorizes the purchase of items through cooperative purchasing programs of the State of Missouri (the “Program”); and

WHEREAS, the purchase of the 2024 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 truck falls under the Missouri State Purchasing Contract with Don Brown Chevrolet; and

WHEREAS, City staff finds the cost of the truck pursuant to the Program to be reasonable;  
and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen deems this vehicle replacement and purchase necessary and has budgeted funds for said purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CRESTWOOD, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Board of Aldermen hereby approves the purchase of a 2024 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 truck pursuant to a quote received from Don Brown Chevrolet, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, in the total sum not to exceed Forty-Two Thousand and Four Hundred Fifty- One Dollars (\$42,451.00).

SECTION 2: The Board of Aldermen hereby designates the Ford Fusion as surplus property and authorizes the sale of the surplus equipment.

SECTION 3: The Mayor, City Administrator and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute such documents and to take such other actions as may be reasonably necessary to approve this purchase and to carry out the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen and its approval by the Mayor.
