IN AMENDMENT OF TITLE 10 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CRANSTON, 2005, ENTITLED "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" (Violation of Posted Weight Limit – Natick Avenue Bridge)

It is ordained by the City Council of the City of Cranston as follows:

SECTION 1. Title 10, Chapter 10.12 of the Code of the City of Cranston, 2005, entitled "Traffic Regulations for Specific Streets", is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new section:

Sec. 10.12.235: Natick Avenue Bridge – Posted Weight Limit.

The use of motor trucks in excess of seven (7) tons gross weight on the Natick Avenue Bridge (located approximately one-half (1/2) mile south of Valley View Drive, and two hundred (200) feet north of the municipal boundary with the Town of West Warwick) is prohibited, and the chief of police or his designee is directed to cause conspicuous signs to be placed on such highway giving notice of such prohibition; provided, however, that nothing contained herein shall effect the use of such bridge by any fire truck, city public works department truck, police vehicle, ambulance, or other motor truck using such highway in any emergency.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final adoption.
