AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A THREE-WAY STOP, ON Curran RD. AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH HIGHLAND AVE..

The Town of Cumberland ordains:

Section 1.

Stop signs shall be placed on the northern and southern side of Curran Rd., at its intersection with Highland Ave., and a stop sign shall be placed on the eastern side of Highland Ave., at its intersection with Curran Rd..

Section 2.

The Director of Public works shall cause said signs to be conspicuously placed on said streets and highways designating said restrictions.

Section 3.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and shall repeal any ordinances now in effect.


