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AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING THE TOWN OF CUMBERLAND WATER RATES

The Town of Cumberland ordains:-

Section I. Appendix C of the Town of Cumberland Code of Ordinances entitled "Schedule of Fees and Charges" is hereby amended as to the water rate schedule as follows:

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*The per 1,000-gallon rates in effect on the date of the passage of this appendix as set forth above shall be adjusted annually by the percentage less than or equal to any tax increase which may be approved by the Town Council (through the annual tax levy), provided that any such increase does not exceed the rates adequate to pay for all costs associated with the municipal water supply as more fully and completely set forth in § 45-39.1-5 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended.

*The purchased water surcharge shall be adjusted by the Water Superintendent as required due to increases in the wholesale rate for water from any wholesale provider as approved by the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission (RIPUC). The increase in the surcharge shall be equal to any future RIPUC-approved wholesale rate increase and shall take effect immediately upon notification of the rate increase by any wholesale provider.

Debt reduction surcharge. The collection of a debt reduction surcharge for the purpose of recovering debt shall remain in effect in accordance with Ordinance No. 15-12 as

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28	approved by the Town Council.
29 30 31 32	Collection of outstanding water and sewer bills shall result in termination of water service to the subject property until such time that the outstanding balances are collected and/or a lien being placed against the subject property and may result in tax sale to collect outstanding balances.
33 34 35	Said water bills shall be due and payable on the date stated therein, and all water bills remaining unpaid 31 days thereafter shall carry until collected, a penalty of 14% upon the unpaid amount and a penalty of \$5 each billing period.
36 37	Monetary and percentage terms may vary slightly due to round-off effect to nearest whole dollar or nearest whole percentage point.
38 39 40	Any customer using an average of 100,000 gallons or more per month will be billed monthly. All other customers shall be billed at such times as determined and agreed upon by the Finance Director and the Water Superintendent.
41 42 43 44 45 46 47 48	Infrastructure surcharge. Funds which are budgeted and/or collected through the infrastructure revenue and expense lines and capital improvement expense line of the approved annual water fund budget which are not expended in each fiscal year shall be transferred to a restricted water infrastructure fund for the purpose of completing infrastructure projects within the water system. The funds shall be transferred to the restricted water infrastructure fund within 90 days of the end of each fiscal year, and the amount shall be recommended by the Finance Director and Water Superintendent and approved by the Town Council, subject to changes proposed by the annual audit.
49 50 51	Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
