

CITY OF CUSHING
ORDINANCE NO. 5-21-18-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15-61 OF THE CUSHING CITY CODE
CREATING A LIBRARY ADVISORY BOARD, SETTING THE NUMBER OF
MEMBERS AT SEVEN, STAGGERING TERMS OF BOARD MEMBERS;
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CUSHING
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Cushing City Code Section 15-61 Amended. That the Cushing City Code is hereby
amended as follows:

§ 15-61 Advisory board.

- A. There is hereby created a library advisory board consisting of seven members appointed by the board of commissioners for terms of three years.
- B. The term of two members of the library advisory board shall expire each year. The term of three members of the library advisory board shall expire every third year.
- C. The library advisory board shall advise the city on matters relating to the Cushing Public Library and library services.

Section 2. Severability. Severability is intended throughout and within the provisions of this ordinance. If any provision, including any exception, part, phrase, or term, or the application thereof to any persons or circumstances is held invalid, the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby and the validity of the ordinance in any and all other respects shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Declaration of Emergency. That for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
