

RESOLUTION NO. 16 OF 2023
DALTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF DALTON, LACKAWANNA COUNTY, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA PURSUANT TO THE WATERSHED RESTORATION AND PROTECTION PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$300,000) DOLLARS TO BE UTILIZED FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE STREAMSIDE PARK IN DALTON BOROUGH. FURTHER, AUTHORIZING DALTON BOROUGH COUNCIL PRESIDENT WILLIAM BRANDT AND DALTON BOROUGH COUNCILMAN BRIAN MALAMUD TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT THE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING AND TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS AND AGREEMENTS BETWEEN DALTON BOROUGH AND THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA NECESSARY TO FACILITATE AND ASSIST IN OBTAINING THE AFOREMENTIONED GRANT.

WHEREAS, Dalton Borough Council has determined to submit an application to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 pursuant to the Watershed Restoration and Protection Program in order to facilitate modifications and improvements to Streamside Park, Dalton Borough, Lackawanna County.

NOW THEREFORE, be it *Resolved* by the Council of the Borough of Dalton, Lackawanna County, that Dalton Council President and other Appropriate Officials of the Borough of Dalton are hereby authorizing the execution and submission of an application for grant funding from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania pursuant to the Watershed Restoration and Protection Program in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand (\$300,000) Dollars to be utilized for improvements to the Streamside Park in Dalton Borough. Further, authorizing Dalton Borough Council President William Brandt and Dalton Borough Councilman Brian Malamud to execute and submit the application for grant funding and to execute all documents and agreements between Dalton Borough and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania necessary to facilitate and assist in obtaining the aforementioned grant.

SECTION 1. This Resolution is effective immediately upon passage.

SECTION 2. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion. The Borough reserves the right to amend this Resolution or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Resolution and the effective administration thereof.




