WHEREAS, this past practice has limited the elected member of the Committee designated as the chair, and;


WHEREAS, N.J.S. 40A:63-2(a)(1) states, "The elected officers of every township shall be the members of the township committee . . .", and;

WHEREAS, there is no such motion restriction placed upon the chair in a township form of government in New Jersey state law, administrative code or as adopted at §5-10(I) of the Code of the Township of Deerfield.


