

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-7

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DOYLESTOWN, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING CHAPTER 15, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, PART 3, GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS, AT SECTION 302 OF THE DOYLESTOWN BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ADDING A PORTION OF EAST STATE STREET TO THE LIST OF LOADING ZONES WHERE PARKING IS PROHIBITED

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S.A. §§ 102, *et seq.*, provides that the corporate powers of the Borough Council of Doylestown Borough (the "Borough Council") includes the ability to make regulations as may be necessary for the health, safety, and general welfare of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, Sections 1202(12) and 1202(31) of the Pennsylvania Borough Code provide that Borough Council may make regulations necessary to regulate streets and parking within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 15 of the Doylestown Borough Code of Ordinances ("Doylestown Borough Code") regulates parking, motor vehicles, and traffic within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 15, Section 302 of the Doylestown Borough Code provides a list of loading zones whereupon it shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle or tractor; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council desires to add a portion of East State Street to the list of loading zones, where it is unlawful for any person to park any vehicle or tractor; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council determined that the proposed addition of the loading zone at this location is necessary to regulate streets and parking within the Borough and to promote the health, safety, and general welfare of Borough residents; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments have been advertised, considered, and reviewed in accordance with the Pennsylvania Borough Code; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, be it **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by the Borough Council as follows:

- I. Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 3, General Parking Regulations, Section 302, Loading and Unloading, of the Doylestown Borough Code of Ordinances is hereby AMENDED by ADDING the following, in alphabetical order by street name to the existing table provided at Subsection (2):**

District	Street	Side	Between
—	East State Street	South	Beginning at a point 70 feet west of its intersection with Donaldson Street and continuing 62 feet in a westerly direction

II. Partial Repealer.

All other provisions of the Borough Code, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect. All other Ordinances or provisions of the Borough Code inconsistent herewith or in conflict with any of the terms hereof, to the extent of said inconsistencies or conflicts, are hereby specifically repealed.

III. Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any section, clause, sentence, part or provision thereof shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional section, clause, sentence or part of a provision had not been included herein.

IV. Effective Date.

All provisions of this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after the approval and adoption.
