Expense to date total \$994.40 for "Save the Dates" postcard mailer, deposit for "Movie Night", stickers for auto windshield of 50<sup>TH</sup> Birthday logo and mailing cost for initial round of business sponsorships or donations.

Second round of Sponsorship and donation letters underway.

Contact has been made with Double Oake Police Department regarding staffing for all birthday events and their overtime will be included in event budgeting.

Primary 50<sup>th</sup> Birthday event will be Noon to 5pm in John B Wright Park on May 18th.

Vendor booth space available for \$50 and link on town website. This is not a cost to the town and 100% revenue to help fund the 50<sup>th</sup> birthday events.

Food truck vendors have been identified and contracts pending review.
