ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DUMONT, COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ESTABLISHING CHAPTER 290 OF THE BOROUGH CODE – PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR UNLAWFUL ACTIVITIES OF MINORS

Chapter 290

Parental Responsibility for Unlawful Activities of Minors

§290-1

Parental Responsibility for Unlawful Activities of Minors

A Parent, Guardian, or other person having legal custody of a juvenile under the age of 18 years who fails or neglects to exercise reasonable supervision and control of the conduct of such juvenile shall be liable to a violation of the within borough ordinance if:

A. Such Juvenile engages in conduct, either by act or omission, which if engaged in by an adult would constitute a disorderly person's offense or crime and said parent, guardian, or other person having legal custody of the juvenile shall have actual knowledge or implied knowledge of the conduct of the juvenile, and the failure or neglect of said parent, guardian or other person to exercise reasonable control or supervision is causally related to said conduct of the juvenile

§290-2

Penalties

1st Offense

\$500 Fine

2nd Offense

\$1,000 Fine

3rd or Subsequent Offense Mandatory Court Appearance, fine of not less than \$1,500 nor more than \$2,500, imprisonment in jail for a period not to exceed 90 days or community service at the Court's discretion
