AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST BRUNSWICK, COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 209, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO INCLUDE VIOLATIONS FOR PARKING OBSTRUCTIONS AND ENCUMBRANCES IN STREETS

WHEREAS, the Township of East Brunswick wishes to adopt an ordinance making obstructions and encumbrances in streets unlawful under the Township Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Township Council find it in the best interest of the safety and welfare of Township residents and visitors to adopt such an ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Council of the Township of East Brunswick, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Chapter 209 Vehicles and Traffic, Article II Parking, is hereby amended to establish new Section 209-17.6, Parking Obstructions and Encumbrances in Streets.

## **Add New**

§209-17.6 Parking Obstructions and Encumbrances in Streets

No person shall obstruct or encumber any street, road, highway, public lane, alley, or parking space within the public right-of-way by placing thereon any object, such as garbage cans, furniture, boxes, lumber, traffic cones, or any other item whatsoever, so as to obstruct or encumber passage or block parking spaces or areas from being available for public use where parking is otherwise legally permitted.

<u>Section 2</u>. This Ordinance may be renumbered for the purpose of codification.

<u>Section 3</u>. Ordinances, resolutions, regulations or parts of ordinances, resolutions, and regulations inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

<u>Section 4</u>. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reasons, the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and, to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared severable.
